Our Vision in Summary

We'll grow by 50% in new facilities , and also provide new ways for you to access hospital services closer to where you live.	We'll have an ongoing relationship with patients and families so we can think ahead about what you will need from us and serve you better.	We will offer you more information and support to help you understand and make decisions about your health.
We'll work with community partners throughout our region to address the root causes of poor health.	We'll build partnerships with family doctors and community service providers to create a true network of supports for you.	We'll create more clinics in more places, providing care that doesn't need to be in a large hospital.
We'll rebuild our old facilities, and create new ones for the specialized care of children and seniors.	We'll attract the world's best talent to deliver care to you and educate the next generation of health care workers.	We'll create new jobs in our region in healthcare services, information technology, research, teaching, facility maintenance and other fields.

Highlights

Milestones and activities from the past couple of months:

- **Master Program update (June 23):** The Master Program Stage 1A was reviewed and approved by HHS' Board of Directors at the June 23rd Board meeting.
- **Partners in Health focus group (June 14):** HHS hosted a joint event with De dwa da dehs nye>s Aboriginal Health Centre and the Hamilton Regional Indian Centre to share information, build knowledge and identify barriers and opportunities to closer partnerships.
- **Town Council presentations (May 24):** HHS President & CEO Rob MacIsaac was invited to present to a special meeting of Hamilton's General Issues Committees to outline HHS's vision for the future. The vision was also presented to the West Lincoln Town Council.
- **Leadership Forum (May 10):** More than 300 leaders from HHS engaged in tabletop exercises and large group discussions around *Our Healthy Future* and building our future vision through partnerships.

What's Next for *Our Healthy Future*?

- The vision outlined in the latest progress report is the first part of stage one in a five-stage process.

- This fall, we will share this first part of our vision with the LHIN Board and the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care's capital planning branch.
- Next, we will start working on the second part of stage one, which will include cost estimates, priorities, and timelines for the vision to take shape. This next stage will take another year or more to complete.
- As we continue with the planning process, we will seek additional input from our community and workforce.
