

Our Healthy Future SUMMIT

fter a busy year gathering input from stakeholders, our vision for the future of care at Hamilton Health Sciences (HHS) is taking shape and we now need to imagine how that vision will integrate with the broader health system. To support this process, HHS is hosting a one-day summit on March 1, with an extensive representation of community service organizations from Hamilton and West Niagara invited to hear our draft vision and provide feedback. The summit will include discussions around the collaboration required to make our vision a reality, a 'marketplace' for ideas, and a workshop where we will cocreate prototypes of new and innovative ways to organize healthcare services in our communities.

Engagement has been an important part of the *Our Healthy Future* planning process, and the summit will further contribute to these community conversations. It will be followed by more Community Conversation events and staff engagement initiatives in the coming months, leading up to the submission of our vision and master program to the Board of Directors in June 2016.
